

During this year's holiday will facilitate cultural exchanges 48 young people from five different countries in Europe - different territory, constitutionally, politically and culturally.


The topic is cohabitation with nature and location of the man in the natural world around him.

Non-formal education will be used throughout the project in order to promote a healthy and active lifestyle in mutual respect for another human being and the world around him.




Accommodation:

How to get to Schronisko Górskie "Głodówka"



From Warszawa (Warsaw):

Airport "Okęcie" – Dworzec Centralny (Central Railway stage 1 Station)

City transport - Bus 175 - journey time about 30 minutes

Warszawa to Zakopane City stage 2 PKP - the National Railway - journey time about 7 hours

PKS - Autobus - journey time about około 7 hours

Caution! There is a need for change and connecting transport in Krakow!

Zakopane City – Polana Głodówka stage 3 Bus – local transport - journey time about 30 minutes



From Kraków:

Airport Balice to Kraków Dworzec Główny (Central Bus stage 1 and Railway Station)

City transport - Bus 292, 208 (in the night 902)- journey time about 30 minutes

suburban railway "Balice Ekspres" - journey time about 10 minutes

stage 2 Kraków to Zakopane City PKP - the National Railway - journey time about 2,5 hours

PKS - Autobus - journey time about 2,5 hours

stage 3: Zakopane City – Polana Głodówka Bus - local transport - journey time about 30 minutes


